Our Climate



The average January temperatures in Brawley range from a high of 70 degrees and a low of 39. That is why climate makes our region an attractive destination for the thousands of Winter Visitors who visit here annually.

Summer months in this desert area find residents appreciating air conditioning. Average July temperatures range from a high of 107 degrees to a low of 74.

The record high temperature in Brawley was 123.98 degrees on August 16, 1903, and the record low temperature was 15.98 degrees on January 22, 1937.

Average annual precipitation is 3.15 inches. The most rainfall in one month was 7.08 inches in September 1939. A rare snowfall in December 1932 brought a total of 3.0 inches
