#### RESPONSE TO COMMENT LETTER 2

**Date of Letter:** April 24, 2014

**Response to Comment 2-1:** The comment notes receipt of notice regarding the Seville Solar Farm Complex EIR. Comment request that if any evidence of human habitation is encountered during construction, the County immediately cease work and contact the tribe. Mitigation measure MM 4.7.4 on page 4.7-23 of the Draft EIR includes protocol in the event that human remains are discovered. The protocol includes halting or diverting construction; contacting the Imperial County Coroner; notifying the NAHC if the remain are determined to be Native American, etc.
