NOTICE OF INTENT

NOTICE OF INTENT IS HERBY GIVEN for the preparation of a Negative Declaration Mitigated Negative Declaration for Initial Study #19-0031 for Conditional Use Permit #19-0026 (pursuant to the *California Environmental Quality Act* and the County of Imperial's *Rules and Regulations to Implement California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as amended*.

LEAD AGENCY: Imperial County Planning & Development Services Department (ICPDS)

APPLICANT: Pyramid Construction & Aggregate, Inc.

PROJECT LOCATION: 3737 American Girl Road, Winterhaven, CA

The project site is is not listed on any list under Government Code Section 65962.5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Applicant is requesting to amend existing Conditional Use Permit # 16-0008 to establish a permanent asphalt batch plant. The plant will be located on the same site as the temporary asphalt plant (40 acres of Federal land). Maximum truck trips 250 daily. The plant will operate in daylight hours, 7:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Starting hour will be 6:00 AM in the summer. The project is located 12.5 miles northwest of Winterhaven, CA.

PUBLIC HEARING: An Imperial County Planning Commission public hearing will be conducted on Wednesday March 10, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. in the County Administration Center (Board Room) located at 940 Main Street, El Centro, CA, 92243 to consider the adoption of the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration, in conjunction with the proposed project.
