PROJECT LOCATION: 10466 Spa Road, Niland, located in the northwestern portion of the Imperial County approximately ¾-miles southeast of the community of Hot Spa. The parcel is identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 002-040-078-000 and is legally described as the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 12, Township 9 South, Range 12 East, S.B.B.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of closing the Hot Spa Solid Waste Site, which is an existing landfill that has reached its maximum permitted capacity pursuant to Title 27 CCR Section 21110. Activities include waste relocation, borrow soil excavation and placement as cover soil, engineered fill placement and compaction, and installation of storm water management features.
