    The proposed project consists of the Glamis Specific Plan (GSP) to guide development within the unincorporated community of Glamis, California in the eastern portion of Imperial County. Centered around the Glamis Beach Store, 143 acre Specific Plan Area is generally bounded by the Imperial Sand Dunes Recreation Area (ISDRA) on the south and by the North Algodones Dunes Wilderness(NADW) on the north. The Specific Plan area is approximately 27 miles east of the City of Brawley and 20 miles north of I-8. The GSP is intended to enhance the experience of existing recreational users of the adjacent areas and implement the County's objectives for the area by facilitating development of recreation-serving land uses and required infrastructure.
